Eligibility of Competitor: All competitors must be 4 years and older, and all competitors must agree by the rules of the organizing committee

Mandatory Equipment:

Uniform – Open Style

Sparring Gear – All Sparring competitors must bring their own safety gear including Chest Protector, Head gear (White, Blue, or Red color), Shin/Instep guard, Forearm guard, protective cup and Mouth guard. – All protectors will NOT be provided

Optional Equipment: Sparring Gloves and Foot/Toes Protector

Sparring – Sparring ONLY competitors must pick up ID before 12:00pm

The competition rules regulate and govern all matters pertaining to Taekwondo competition at all levels sanctioned or promoted by ATU. However the following special section of the Junior Competition (Safety) Rules shall further apply to junior sparring divisions as stated below

Junior Competition (Safety) Rules

1. No Head Contact – Age 7 & under (All Belts) and Age 11 and Under (Color Belt)
 - Any Techniques contacted to the head area which does not cause any injury, will be given a warning by the referee (“Kyung Go”)
 - Any technique, which causes injury to the head area will result in a one-point deduction by the referee
 - If the competitor cannot continue because of the injury to the head area, the attacker will be disqualified. Note: Inability to continue because of fright, crying or loss of will following a kick to the head which did not cause injury does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.
2. Junior Safety Rules – Ages 8-11 (Black Belt), Age 12-13 (all belts), and Age 14-17 (Color Belt)
 - The competitor is allowed to kick to the facial area : however the kick MUST be light contact with absolute control without causing any injury or excessive contact, or the appropriate penalty shall be invoked.
 - The competitor who executes a successful technique (Light contact ONLY) will be awarded.
 - The competitor who executes a kick to the face which results in a minor injury shall receive a one-point deduction (Kam-Jeom). A minor injury is defined as abrasion or bleeding caused by non-excessive contact. The referee, with or without consultation with the tournament physician, shall determine if the abrasion or bleeding is a minor injury, and if the attacker is a non-excessive one.
 - The competitor who executes a kick to the face which results in the inability of the opponent to continue sparring because of injury shall be disqualified. The referee shall determine if the attack is an excessive contact, and if the injury is major one.
3. Age 14-17 (Black Belt) and Senior Division (All Belts)
 - In Regional Championship sparring competition, the senior black belt adult rules shall apply for these divisions.

From Akron Area: 77N → 271N → Take EXIT 23 toward OH-14/BROADWAY AVE/FORBES RD → Stay STRAIGHT to go onto FAIR OAKS RD. → Turn RIGHT onto BROADWAY AVE. → Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto PETTIBONE RD. → Turn LEFT onto SOM CENTER RD/OH-91. → 6835 SOM CENTER RD is on the RIGHT.

From West (Detroit): I-75 S → I-280 S → I-80 E → I-480 E → US 422 E → Take the OH-91 exit toward MORELAND HILLS/SOLON. → Turn RIGHT onto SOM CENTER RD/OH-91. → 6835 SOM CENTER RD is on the LEFT

From South (Columbus): I-71 N → Merge onto I-271 N via EXIT 220 toward ERIE PA. → Take EXIT 23 toward OH-14/BROADWAY AVE/FORBES RD. → Stay STRAIGHT to go onto FAIR OAKS RD. → Turn RIGHT onto BROADWAY AVE Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto PETTIBONE RD. → Turn LEFT onto SOM CENTER RD/OH-91 → 6835 SOM CENTER RD is on the RIGHT.

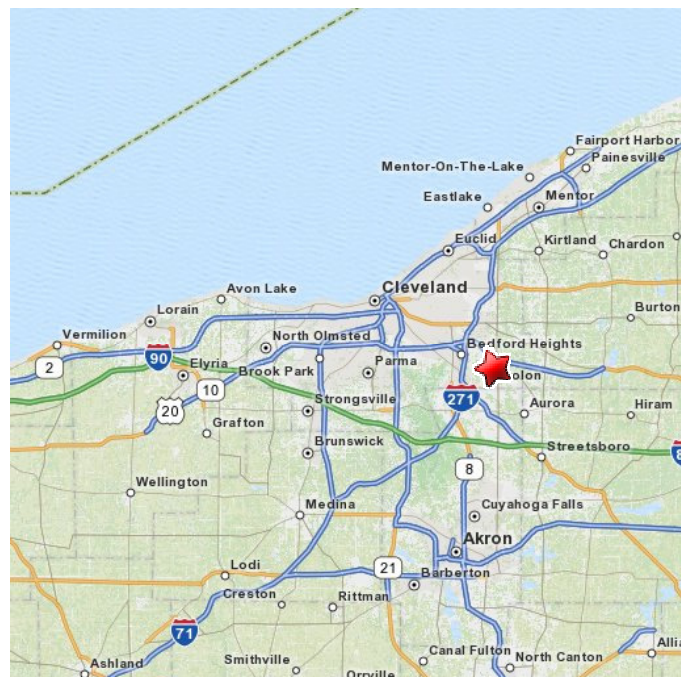
